

# A Working List of the Birds of the Channel Islands

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This Working List includes details of all those bird species recorded in the (British) Channel Islands of Jersey (including Les Écréhous and Les Minquiers), Guernsey (including Herm, Jethou and Lihou), Alderney (including Burhou and the Casquets) and Sark that have been accepted by the islands' respective ornithological committees. Some recent records may not be included, as the relevant committee has not yet verified them. Further details of each species or of individual records can be found in published reports or by contacting the committees directly (see below). Records are updated annually after individual islands' records committees have discussed the preceding year's reports. The report is currently updated to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2013 and the authors are grateful this year to Tim Morley (Alderney), Mick Dryden (Jersey) and Richard Axton (Sark) for their help in maintaining this list.

## Status

To date it has been difficult for the authors to standardise the status of birds in the four islands as interpretation has often differed and coverage has been patchy. As a guideline, however, the following categories have been used to describe status:

In practice, some of the categories have been further elaborated (e.g. fairly common) to give a better impression of status. Examination of the status on different islands shows either interesting zoogeographical patterns (e.g. Brent Goose *Branta bernicla* and Eurasian Jay *Garrulus glandarius*) or limited historical observer coverage (e.g. European Honey-buzzard *Pernis apivorus* and Little Gull *Larus minutus*). It is hoped that both local and visiting birders will see the gaps in the knowledge of Channel Island birds and plan their visits accordingly. Please submit all records to the relevant island's recorder.

### 1. Mute Swan *Cygnus olor*

**Jersey** Rare, usually winter, visitor. NB presence of free-flying and resident feral birds.

**Guernsey** Rare, usually winter, visitor – only one record in 1990's then 10/2005 (3), at least one staying to 10/1/06 and 22-23/4/10 and 6-7/3/11. No free-flying ornamental or feral birds.

**Alderney** Rare, usually winter, visitor - 6 records, 3/1971, 20/11/84, 2/10/95-2/1/96 (2), 16-22/11/2001, 18/7/10 & 29/10/12.

**Sark** 1 record, 21/3/1978.

### 2. Bewick's Swan *Cygnus columbianus*

**Jersey** 3 records, 16/1-22/2/1982, 21/10-6/11/2003 and 3/12/10 (4).

**Guernsey** 1 record, 18/1-10/2/1963 (2).

**Alderney**

### 3. Whooper Swan *Cygnus cygnus*

**Jersey** Rare, usually winter, visitor (9 records). Most recent 30/10-21/11/2010 (8), 9/11/11 and 2/11/12-28/3/13 (3). Several free-living ornamental birds.

**Guernsey** 7 records, 1878/79, 26/1/1963 (2), 5/1/79, 21/10/91, 16/11/93, 19-20/10/2002 and 24/10-31/12/02 (8).

**Alderney** 1 record, 22/10/1990.

### 4. Bean Goose *Anser fabalis*

**Jersey** Rare winter visitor, 2 subspecies, *A. fabalis fabalis* and *A. fabalis rossicus* recorded. Most recent 3-23/1/09 (*rossicus*).

**Guernsey** 4 records, 1879/80, 4/2-24/3/1985, 14/12/2001 and 22/12/03-3/1/04: 2 subspecies, *A. fabalis fabalis* and *A. fabalis rossicus* recorded.

**Alderney** 1 record, 1913.

### 5. Pink-footed Goose *Anser brachyrhynchus*

**Jersey** Rare winter visitor. NB past (?) presence of free-flying ornamental birds. Most recent 3-14/1/2009 (2) and 23/10-25/11/10.

**Guernsey** 5 records, 23/1-1/2/1987 (2), 21/10/2006-13/3/07, 3/10/07-23/5/08, 19/10/12-25/2/13 and 20/10/12-14/3/13 (16).

**Alderney** 1 record, 11/10/12 (21).

**Sark**

**6. Greater White-fronted Goose *Anser albifrons***

**Jersey** Rare spring migrant and winter visitor. NB past (?) presence of free-living ornamental birds.

**Guernsey** Rare winter visitor. 2 subspecies recorded: *A. albifrons albifrons* rare winter visitor: most recent, 1/12/2010-11/2/11 (13) and 2-8/3/13 (12). NB c. 30 free-flying ornamental birds. Greenland White-fronted Goose *A. albifrons flavirostris*: 1 record 4-5/11/2006.

**Alderney** Rare winter visitor.

**Sark** 1 record, 11/12/1967 (9, 1 shot).

**Bar-headed Goose *Anser indicus***

**Jersey** Small numbers of wide-ranging free-flying birds.

**7. Greylag Goose *Anser anser***

**Jersey** Rare spring and autumn migrant: western race *A. anser anser*: most recent flocks include 6/11/2011 (95) and 19/1/13 (8). NB resident feral (eastern race *A. anser rubirostris*) birds very common.

**Guernsey** Rare winter visitor, spring and autumn migrant: western race. NB many free-flying feral birds present and definite wild birds hard to detect: most recent 14/11/2011 (17) and 22/11/11 (3).

**Alderney** Rare winter visitor and spring migrant.

**Sark** Rare winter visitor.

**8. Greater Canada Goose *Branta canadensis***

**Jersey** 6 records, 14/1/1982 (3), 24/2/2005, 30-31/3/05, 7/4/05 (2), 6/4/07 and 15/6/13-2014.

**Guernsey** 4 records, 12/5/1993, 18-19/2/2004, 19/4-21/5/07 and 3/6/10.

**Alderney** 4 records, 5/4/1984 (16), 5/4/85 (20), 13/1/2002 and 3/6/10.

**Sark** 2 records, 23/4/1969 and 18-19/5/69.

**9. Barnacle Goose *Branta leucopsis***

**Jersey** Rare winter visitor. NB free-flying resident ornamental birds. Has bred locally with Greater White-fronted Goose and hybrids present. Most recent wild 7/12/2010 (7) and 27/12/10-2/1/11 (2).

**Guernsey** No wild records; however, c. 30 free-flying ornamental birds present.

**Alderney** 3 records, 4/11/1968 (4), 1/10/81 and 15/8/93. Origin of birds uncertain.

**10. Brent Goose *Branta bernicla***

**Jersey** Very common autumn migrant and winter visitor. Three subspecies recorded: Dark-bellied *B. bernicla bernicla* are common and Pale-bellied

*B. bernicla hrota* are scarce but annual, Black Brant *B. bernicla nigricans* is a rare visitor that may stay throughout winter – last: 23/2/2008, 28/12/08, 2/12/12, 5/3-4/4 (1-2) and 2-26/11/13 (2).

**Guernsey** Common winter visitor, half of population in Herm. Most records are of *B. bernicla bernicla*; however, *B. bernicla hrota*: rare (8 records) and *B. bernicla nigricans*: 3 records, 8/1-26/3/1999, 5/2-3/4/2005 and 23/12/12-31/3/13.

**Alderney** Scarce autumn migrant and winter visitor.

**Sark** Rare winter visitor.

11. **Red-breasted Goose *Branta ruficollis***

**Jersey** 3 records, 20/10/2009-26/3/10 (2), 9/10/10-9/3/11 and 14/10/13-2014.

**Alderney** Ornamental captive birds held at Rose Farm.

12. **Egyptian Goose *Alopochen aegyptiacus***

**Jersey** 1 record, 18-31/12/2001-15/1/02 (3).

13. **Ruddy Shelduck *Tadorna ferruginea***

**Jersey**

**Guernsey** (probable escape 26/6/2012-13)

**Alderney** 1 record, 21/3-30/4/1995.

14. **Common Shelduck *Tadorna tadorna***

**Jersey** Rare, mainly winter, visitor and scarce migrant. First breeding record 2010, may have bred 2011.

**Guernsey** Virtual resident in small numbers. Bred 1969 and regularly from 1998.

**Alderney** Rare winter visitor and occasional resident. Likely to have bred on Burhou (2012).

15. **Mandarin Duck *Aix galericulata***

**Jersey** Scarce, occasional breeding species, origins of all 'wild' birds uncertain.

**Guernsey** Occasional, assumed escaped, birds recorded. Most recent: 1/1-7/2/2011 (2) and 28-30/4/12.

16. **Eurasian Wigeon *Anas penelope***

**Jersey** Scarce winter visitor and annual migrant.

**Guernsey** Scarce winter visitor and migrant.

**Alderney** Rare winter visitor.

**Sark** 2 recent records, 20/1/1966 and 12/3/68 – both shot.

17. **American Wigeon *Anas americana***

**Jersey**

**Guernsey** 1 female recorded: 9/10/1985-14/3/86, 18/1-31/3/87, 10/10/87-19/3/88 and 2/10/88-2/3/89.

18. **Gadwall *Anas strepera***

**Jersey** Rare resident and winter visitor, first record 15/12/1968. Increased and may be resident some years. First bred 2000.

**Guernsey** Rare migrant and visitor first record 22-26/4/1974. Annual in recent years e.g. c. 50 in 96/97.

**Alderney** Rare migrant and winter visitor. Annual in recent years.

19. **Eurasian Teal *Anas crecca***

**Jersey** Common winter visitor and migrant.

**Guernsey** Fairly common winter visitor and migrant.

**Alderney** Common winter visitor.

**Sark** Rare winter visitor.

20. **Green-winged Teal *Anas carolinensis***

**Jersey**

**Guernsey** 1 record, 1-8/12/2001-16/4/02.

**Alderney**

21. **Northern Mallard *Anas platyrhynchos***

**Jersey** Common resident and migrant. Many birds showing characteristics of domestic varieties living wild.

**Guernsey** Common resident, fairly common winter visitor and migrant.

**Alderney** Common resident and winter visitor.

22. **Northern Pintail *Anas acuta***

**Jersey** Rare winter visitor and rare, mainly spring and autumn, migrant.

**Guernsey** Scarce winter visitor and migrant.

**Alderney** 6 records, 1863, 29-31/10/1978, 21/1/85, 4/4/90, 17/2/93 and 23/2/2003.

**Sark** 1 record, 5/2/1971 (2: shot).

23. **Garganey *Anas querquedula***

**Jersey** Rare spring migrant, occasional in autumn. Bred 1952.

**Guernsey** Scarce spring migrant, occasional in autumn.

**Alderney** 1 record, 24-28/3/2000.

24. **Blue-winged Teal *Anas discors***

**Jersey**

**Guernsey**

**Alderney** 1 record, 19-20/9/1983 (3, 2 shot!)

25. **Northern Shoveler *Anas clypeata***

**Jersey** Occasional breeding species, scarce annual migrant and winter visitor.

**Guernsey** Scarce winter visitor and migrant.

**Alderney** Rare winter visitor and migrant.

**Sark** 1 record, 18/3/1967.

26. **Red-crested Pochard *Netta ruffina***

**Jersey** Occasional migrant; however, scarce resident in 1980's (origins unknown). Most recent wild, 21/1/2010 (13).

**Guernsey** 1 record, 6/8/2005 (origins unknown). A few recent records but presumed escapes.

**27. Common Pochard *Aythya ferina***

**Jersey** Occasional breeding species (first bred 1993), scarce migrant and winter visitor.

**28. Ring-necked Duck *Aythya collaris***

**Jersey** 1 record, 25/2-9/3/2001 and 1-7/7/01.

**Guernsey** Scarce winter visitor and migrant. Occasional in summer. First bred in 2000 now breeds most years.

**Jersey** Rare winter visitor and autumn migrant. Most recent 6/4/2007, 11-17/5/09 and 17/11/13.

**Guernsey** Rare winter visitor and autumn migrant (13 records).

**Alderney** 3 records, 9/1/1982, 17/1/1/87 and 24/2/87.

**32. Lesser Scaup *Aythya affinis***

**Jersey**

**Guernsey** 2 records, 15/11/2009-13/4/10 (2) and 25/10-14/11/10 (presumed one of 09-10 birds).

**33. Common Eider *Somateria mollissima***

**Jersey** Scarce migrant and winter visitor – occasional individuals have stayed throughout year.

**Guernsey** Scarce winter and very rare summer visitor.

**Alderney** Scarce winter visitor and migrant.

**Sark** 1 record, 1/12/1977.

**34. Long-tailed Duck *Clangula hyemalis***

**Jersey** Rare, generally in winter. Recorded each winter since 2007.

**Guernsey** Rare, generally in winter (13 records). Most recent 22/11/2008 and 26/12/10-1/4/11.

35. **Common Scoter *Melanitta nigra***

**Jersey** Scarce, sometimes common, winter visitor and common autumn migrant, occasional in summer.

**Guernsey** Scarce winter visitor and migrant.

**Sark** 3 records, 27/4/1969 (2), 10/2/83 (2) and 21/2/85.

36. **Surf Scoter *Melanitta perspicillata***

**Jersey** 2 records, 9/12/2007 and 15/2-14/3/09.

**Jersey** Rare but annual winter visitor and spring migrant.

**Guernsey** Rare winter visitor and migrant (2 records since 1987).

38. **Bufflehead *Bucephala albeola***

**Jersey**

**Guernsey** 1 record, 8-11/11/1967 (eventually shot!).

39. **Common Goldeneye *Bucephala clangula***

**Jersey** Rare winter visitor and migrant (was regular in small numbers in 1980s). Most recent, 4 in 2008, 7/1/09, 17/2/09 and 8/1/11.

**Guernsey** Rare winter visitor and migrant (3 records since 2000; most recent, 9/12/10-18/3/11).

**Alderney** 2 records, 2/1/1979 and 19/1/2000.

40. **Smew *Mergellus albellus***

**Jersey** Rare winter visitor (not annual). Most recent, 28/12/2010 and 5-8/1/11.

**Guernsey** Rare winter visitor (8 records, most recent 1998).

**Alderney** 3 records, 1918, 5/2/85 and 10/1/97 (2).

41. **Red-breasted Merganser *Mergus serrator***

**Jersey** Common winter visitor and autumn migrant.

**Guernsey** Scarce winter visitor and migrant.

**Alderney** Scarce winter visitor.

42. **Goosander *Mergus merganser***

**Jersey** Rare but annual winter visitor and migrant.

**Guernsey** Rare to scarce winter visitor and migrant.

**Alderney** 1 record, 10/1/1997 (3).

**43. Ruddy Duck *Oxyura jamaicensis***

**Jersey** 7 records, 21/1-27/12/1993, 4/11/93-23/1/94, 8/10/93-15/3/94, 29/1/2000, 28/3/01, 27/2-5/7/01 and 13-14/1/03.

**44. Common Quail *Corturnix corturnix***

**Jersey** Rare summer visitor and migrant. Occasional breeder until 1932. Escaped domestic, and possibly feral, birds confuse status. Most recent 9/1, 16/1 and 19/5/2011 (3), 2/11/12 and 2/6/13.

**Guernsey** Rare, mainly spring migrant (10 records since 1969; however, 8/6/2005 was first for 10 years). Most recent 14/10/08. Bred Herm 1906.

**Alderney** Formerly rare migrant. Bred 1964.

**Sark** 5 records, 29/5/1967, 7/6/72, 2/9/87, 17/6/89 and 19/4/90.

**45. Red-legged Partridge *Alectoris rufa***

**Jersey** Rare, illegally introduced (several times?), breeds occasionally. Small numbers present 2002-2004, increasing from 2005. Status in 2012 unclear but present.

**Guernsey** Regularly introduced – may be fairly common.

**Alderney**

**Sark** Several (failed?) introductions, most recently (successfully?) on Brecqhou with birds regularly appearing on Sark. 1 on 30/4/2006.

**46. Grey Partridge *Perdix perdix***

**Jersey** Illegally introduced (several times?) current status unclear.

**Guernsey** Regularly introduced (including recently) – not self supporting. Small number may be present.

**Alderney** Introduced 1980, initially flourished but not seen since 5/2008.

**47. Common Pheasant *Phasianus colchicus***

**Jersey** Abundant resident, introduced (regularly!).

**Guernsey** Regularly introduced, including Herm and Jethou. Common resident.

**Alderney** Common resident, introduced 1986.

**Sark** Breeding resident, introduced 1968/69.

**48. Red-throated Diver *Gavia stellata***

**Jersey** Scarce spring and common autumn migrant, scarce winter visitor.

**Guernsey** Rare migrant and winter visitor.

**Alderney** Scarce winter visitor.

**Sark** 3 records, 1/8/1977, 4/2/84 & 16-17/2/91.

**49. Black-throated Diver *Gavia arctica***

**Jersey** Scarce autumn migrant and rare winter visitor.

**Guernsey** Scarce migrant and winter visitor.

**Alderney** Scarce winter visitor. Single 13/12/2002 was first since 1994.

**Sark** Rare winter visitor.

**50. Pacific Diver *Gavia pacifica***

**Jersey**

**Guernsey** 1 record, 2/1-28/3/2010 and 8/1-8/2/11.

**51. Great Northern Diver *Gavia immer***

**Jersey** Scarce autumn migrant and winter visitor.

**Guernsey** Scarce migrant and winter visitor.

**Alderney** Scarce winter visitor.

**Sark** Rare winter visitor.

**52. Black-browed Albatross *Thalassarche melanophris***

**Jersey** 1 record, 11/6/2000.

**Guernsey** 1 record, 24/5-28/7/2012.

**Alderney** 1 record 20-28/6/2012 (same bird as above).

**Jersey** 2 records, 30/4/2002 and 4/6/08. Considered by observers to be *Thalassarche* sp.

**53. Fulmar *Fulmarus glacialis***

**Jersey** Common resident and migrant – first recorded breeding, 1975.

**Guernsey** Fairly common resident and scarce migrant – first recorded breeding, 1985.

**Alderney** Scarce resident and migrant – first recorded breeding 1975.

**Sark** Common resident – first recorded breeding, 1986.

**54. Cory's Shearwater *Calonectris borealis***

**Jersey** Rare autumn migrant. 5 before 1991, more recently: 1/10/91 (4), 20/10/91(3), 10/10/98, 18/8/99 and 9/9/2002.

**Guernsey** 8 records, 22/10/1967, 10/10/88, 14/9/94, 13/9/98 (2) 14/8/99 (4), 5/8/2001 (2), 16/10/02 (2) and 5/10/08.

**Alderney** 3 records, 12/9/1977, 21/9/77 and 11/6/98.

**Sark**

**55. Great Shearwater *Puffinus gravis***

**Jersey** 1 record, 8/9/1995.

**Guernsey** 5 records, 25/7/1950 ("sizeable flocks"), 27/9/59 (23), 28/8/95, 8/9/95 (20+) and 25/10/98.

**Alderney** 3 records, 6/6/1998, 7/6/98 (6) and 11/9/98.

**Sark**

**56. Sooty Shearwater *Puffinus griseus***

**Jersey** Rare autumn migrant.

**Guernsey** Scarce autumn migrant; however, has increased e.g. 6/10/2000 (352!) and over 100 annually in recent years.

**Alderney** Occasional autumn migrant. Most recent 21/9/2006 (2) and 1/7/10.

**57. Manx Shearwater *Puffinus puffinus***

**Jersey** Common, mainly spring and autumn migrant and summer visitor.

**Guernsey** Scarce migrant, recorded also in summer and winter.

**Alderney** Regular autumn migrant and summer visitor.

**Sark** Summer visitor, has bred occasionally since 1977.
